Services in Sheffield

Do you find it difficult using standard public transport?

**Do you want to be able to get out and about, meet new people and make new friends?
Don't worry; Door 2 Door may be able to help.**

The service

Door 2 Door services are designed for people who cannot use standard public transport. Each service will pick you up from your home and can take you around your local area and beyond.

Door 2 Door is great for meeting new people, making new friends and being able to visit places you couldn't get to before.

For example, if you want to travel to the city centre or a local supermarket, Shopper Bus is the best service for you. It offers transport from your home at certain times and on certain days. Please see the timetable on page 10 in this leaflet for details of journeys from where you live.

If you need to travel at a certain time, and to a destination not available on Shopper Bus (for example, if you are visiting a friend in hospital, or travelling to an evening class) then our City Ride or Community Car journeys will suit your needs better.

You can also travel outside Sheffield by using the Community Car Scheme which is provided by volunteers using their own transport.

Door 2 Door services aren't just for individuals. If you are a member of a group that wants to use a minibus, you can use the Group Travel scheme.

How do I apply?

If you think Door 2 Door can help you get out and about, you will need to contact your local Door 2 Door operator and apply over the phone with one of our friendly advisors.

Applying is simple and free. All you need to do is follow the three steps below:

1. Call your local Door 2 Door operator, Sheffield Community Transport on 0114 2859906. Alternatively, if you are interested in group travel in the Bradway, Dore or Manor areas, call either Manor Community Transport on 0114 2654275 or Transport 17 on 0114 2362962
2. When you call, the advisor will go through the application process with you
3. Once you have applied we will send you out a welcome pack which includes the following;
 - Your registration number
 - A guide to your local services
 - A free welcome gift
 - Other useful information.

When you apply you will be able to pre-book your first return trip with us, so if you have a journey in mind please let us know.

Booking

All Door 2 Door services require advance booking. Your Door 2 Door operator will do their best to accommodate all bookings, but availability is limited and sometimes not all booking requests can be met.

You can book your journey with Sheffield Community Transport by calling 0114 285 9906 between 0900 and 1230 Monday to Friday.

Please note that due to its popularity you must give seven days notice for City Ride. For all other services at least two working days notice is required.

Please note that out of office hours, on weekends and on Bank Holidays, you can leave messages on an answer machine.

When booking, you will need to tell us the following details:

- Your name or registration number
- The date and times you want to travel
- Where you want to be picked up and dropped off
- If you need space for a companion, or if you need to travel with an assistance dog
- If you want to take a mobility aid or wheelchair (unfortunately not all wheelchairs or scooters will fit on the buses, so please ask when you book if yours can be accommodated).

Being Flexible

Because of demand for Door 2 Door services, the more flexible you are with your days and times of travel, the more likely we will be able to take you. Let us know how flexible you are when you make your booking.

How to cancel a booking

If you find you need to cancel your journey all you need to do is contact us by calling 0114 285 9906. There is an answer phone for messages left out of office hours. This allows us to offer the journey time to somebody else.

Other operators

There are three other, smaller community transport providers in Sheffield who may be more suited to your travel needs.

Manor Community Transport

Provides group travel services for people living in the Manor area of Sheffield.

All bookings and enquiries can be made on 0114 265 4275. An answer machine is available if the office is closed. Or you can send an email to manormobeel@googlemail.com

Sheffield Dial-a-Ride Club

Provides group travel and Dial-a-Ride services for people living across Sheffield. Services operate between 0830 and 1730, Monday to Friday, and at all other times if volunteer drivers are available. All bookings and enquiries can be made on 0114 285 9906. Their office is open from 0900 to 1230, Monday to Friday, with an answer machine available at other times.

Transport 17

Provides group travel services for people living in the S17 postcode area, which covers Bradway, Dore and Totley.

All bookings and enquiries can be made on 0114 236 2962. The office is open from 0900 to 1200, Monday to Friday, with an answer machine available at other times.

For example:

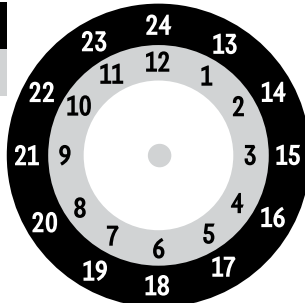
9.00am is shown as 0900
